

## **Technical Information about 3'-Cyclic ADP Ribose**

Name: (1" - 3')- Cyclic adenosine diphosphate ribose (3'-cADPR / v2-cADPR / 1"-3'-qcADPR), sodium salt

**Description:** 3'-cADPR is an analogue of ADP ribose in which position 3' of the southern ribose is connected to position 1" of the second ribose unit yielding a so-called "glycocyclic" macrocyclic ring system consisting of pyrophosphate and riboses.

**Properties:** 3'-cADPR is a regioisomer of the canonical second messenger cADPR (Cat. No. C 005) and of 2'-cADPR (Cat. No. C 406). 3'-cADPR was identified as novel signaling molecule involved in the innate immunity in plants and bacteria (Leavitt et al. 2022, Manik et al. 2022).

**Specification:** Crystallized or lyophilized sodium salt. The free acid or other salt forms are available upon request. Please keep in mind that equal concentrations of the compound may look different in volume due to sensitivity of the lyophilized form to humidity. The compound can even contract to small volume droplets. Normally the product is located in the conical bottom of the tube. Micromolar quantities are determined by UV at  $\lambda_{max}$ .

Purity: Typical analysis is better than 98% (HPLC / UV / 259 nm). The product is not sterile and has not been tested for endotoxins.

**Solubility:** 3'-cADPR has excellent solubility in water and aqueous buffers (≥ 9.5 mM, limits have not been determined). Please rinse tube walls carefully and preferably use ultrasonic or vortex to achieve total and uniform mixing. When opening the tube please make sure that no substance is lost within the cap.

**Stability and Storage:** 3'-cADPR has sufficient stability at room temperature and does not need special care during handling or shipment. Nevertheless, we recommend that the compound should be stored in the freezer, for longer storage periods preferably in freezedried form.

**Toxicity and Safety:** Since 3'-cADPR seems to have tasks in several organisms, it is not unlikely that it will interfere with many cell regulation processes *in vivo*. However, due to the rather small quantities to work with, no health hazards have been reported. Nevertheless please keep in mind, that the *in vivo* properties of this compound are not sufficiently characterized up to now. Avoid skin contact or ingestion and allow only trained personnel to handle the product.
